

Return to School Summary for Parents and Students



This is a summary of the key measures the school has taken as part of its Covid-19 response plan.

The purpose of this plan is to allow students, staff and all members of the school community to work and learn in a safe environment, one in which the risks of spreading Covid-19 have been minimised.

If a student reports that they are feeling unwell they must stay at home.

If a student feels unwell at school they will be isolated and must be tested.

A student must receive a confirmed negative Covid-19 test before returning to school

School Entry

The school building will open at 08.30. Students will have assigned entry points and must go directly to their first class each morning.

The School Day

Students will have the majority of their classes in assigned seats in assigned base rooms in their Year Group bubbles. The school will have a staggered finish based on Year Groups between 15.30-1540 with students exiting accompanied by their teacher.

One Way System

The school will operate a one way system for movement. This one way system is clearly marked with signage and must be followed at all times.

Hand Hygiene

There will be a number of sanitising stations in classes and around the school. There will be a regular stock of towels, soap, and hot water in bathrooms. Students are encouraged to bring their own wipes/sanitising gel also.

Face Coverings

Face coverings are compulsory on the school campus and students should initially bring their own. A school face covering will be provided free of charge.

Uniform

Students will wear their full school uniform to school including their black footwear. They should wear their PE Uniform for the full day on the days that they have P.E and changing rooms will not be in use.

Materials and Lockers

School lockers are not in use. Students will be provided with an individual storage box at their desk. Students should not share any materials and ensure they have all materials with them before they leave for school each morning.

Lunch/Canteen

The school will have staggered lunchtimes from 13.00-13.40 (Senior) and 13.40-14.20 (Junior). The canteen will operate a pre-order and prepay system.

Visitors to the School

Meetings of parents and other visitors for urgent purposes will be by appointment only. Facemasks should be worn and the 2m distancing must be maintained. Parents should not drop in to the school office or drop off forgotten material/lunch.
