Transition Year students will be attending the Gaeltacht in Coláiste Acla, Achill Island from the **9th – 11th Oct.**

The bus will depart Coláiste na Mí at **8am** on **Wed 9th Oct** and return on **Fri 11th Oct** at approx. **5pm.**

They will partake in a wide range of activities **trí Ghaeilge** at the College. The college has two large sports halls and a wide range of water sports activities. The students will have a fully timetabled day from when they arrive under 24hr supervision. Activities may include Surfing, Kayaking, Bog Snorkelling, Archery, Team Building games and Indoor climbing (weather dependant). Social activities are organized each evening such as a céilí in the hall or trips based on local historic sites such as the Deserted Village and Grainneuaile's Castle.

Students stay in local houses with a Bean an Tí, with Breakfast, Dinner and Supper provided each day. Lunch such as soup and sandwiches will be provided at the college.

What to bring

- Two towels
- Old shoes to be worn in the water
- Raincoat
- Swimming gear

House Rules

- Food, aerosols, cameras and phones are not allowed in the bedrooms.
- Phones are given to the bean an tí upon arrival and students have use of their phones from 22:00-22:30 at night.
- Each student is to be in their own room at 22:30 and lights out at 23:00.
- Bedrooms are to be cleaned before breakfast each morning.
- If a student breaks anything in the house, they must pay for it.
- Students are allowed one shower per day.
- Students must pack their bags on the last evening and bring their sheets down on the last day.

Pocket money may be required for a bus stop on route to Achill and possibly in the town if given opportunity. The cost of the trip is covered by the TY entrance fee.
