Uniform Policy

This Policy was ratified by the Board of Management of Coláiste na Mí on the 30th September 2019.

Date of next review: September 2020





The Colaiste na Mí Uniform Policy applies within this school. All students must abide by this Policy. They sign and return the last page of the document to the school which is then kept on file.

In Coláiste na Mí we are very proud to have a uniform which identifies and distinguishes our students. We believe that wearing the school uniform is conducive to good behaviour and helps to focus students.

It is understood that students choosing to enrol in our school accept that the full school uniform (including the wearing of the appropriate school shoes) must be worn during the school day and also in travelling to and from school.

Parents are asked to show their support in this regard by cooperating fully with the school in ensuring that students wear the full school uniform every day.

- 1. All Coláiste na Mí students are expected to maintain a high standard of personal hygiene.
- 2. All student's hair must be clean and tidy at all times. Long hair should be tied back.
- 3. All students are required to wear the full uniform (as outlined in the uniform list) during the school day and while travelling to and from school. This includes wearing <u>ALL</u> black footwear with <u>NO</u> <u>obvious logos/ markings/designs</u>. Girls may if they wish wear Navy Blue Dubes to school.
- 4. <u>Appropriate sports runners</u> must be worn by all students for PE class and when wearing the school PE uniform. In the interest of health and safety, casual footwear such as converse/pomps etc will not be permitted to be worn during PE.
- 5. All students are required to wear the full school uniform when representing the school competitively and on school trips. Any student who is not dressed in the appropriate school uniform will not be permitted to represent the school or travel on school trips.
- 6. Any student leaving the school premises during the school day must remain in full school uniform.
- 7. Boys must wear the appropriate <u>navy blue school trousers</u>.
- 8. Girls must wear the appropriate navy blue school trousers or the Coláiste na Mí skirt.
- 9. Students are required to wear appropriate hair bands/nets during some practical classes.
- 10. Just one pair of (non-hooped) <u>small stud sized earrings</u> is acceptable, regardless of the number of piercings. No facial piercings are permitted.
- 11. No jacket other than the school jacket (supplied by Kaideen & Co. Ltd) may be worn under any circumstance.
- 12. The Coláiste na Mí, PE uniform must be <u>worn for all PE classes</u> but may not be worn for any other purpose. The wearing of the PE uniform during the school day (except for PE class) is strictly forbidden.
- 13. On occasion the PE uniform may be permitted to be worn on sport related outings. Parents will be informed in advance when this is deemed necessary. Students who are not dressed in the appropriate school uniform will not be permitted to travel on school trips.
- 14. The wearing of jewellery is not allowed in PE class from a health and safety perspective.
- 15. It is expected that students and parents <u>maintain and clean the uniform</u> and that pupils wear their uniform with pride.

IMPORTANT NOTE

• It is the responsibility of each parent/guardian to ensure every item of their child's uniform is labelled clearly with their child's name. Please use a waterproof marker. **The school**

cannot take any responsibility for any item of student property either lost, stolen or damaged while in school.

- We advise parents/guardians to place an identifiable mark eg a small ribbon/button on the school jacket in a discreet location for easy identification.
- Regular uniform checks will take place.
- There will be regular reminders to students and parents about adhering to the uniform policy.
- If a student attends school without the full school uniform, they may be provided with <u>a loan of the missing item/s of school uniform</u> to be worn for the school day.
- For students who develop a pattern of coming to school out of uniform, their Parent/Guardian will be contacted and the appropriate measures adopted as the school authorities deem fit.
- Students in breach of any school Policy will be dealt with in accordance with our Code of Behaviour.

OUTLINE OF SCHOOL UNIFORM (2019/20)

All the items listed below are a compulsory part of the Coláiste na Mí school uniform. They must be worn every day by all students attending the school.

School uniform which can <u>only</u> be purchased from the school uniform supplier (Kaideen & Co Ltd)

- Coláiste na Mí green waterproof jacket with navy fleece lining
- Coláiste na Mí green v neck jumper for Junior students
- Coláiste na Mí blue v neck jumper for Senior students
- · Coláiste na Mí school tie
- Coláiste na Mí tartan skirt for girls

School uniform which can be purchased separately by parents

- Navy trousers (Girls & Boys) (Trousers are also available for purchase at a reasonable price from our Uniform suppliers)
- 5 long sleeved white shirts (Shirts are also available for purchase at a reasonable price from our Uniform suppliers)
- Plain flat, black footwear (no obvious markings or logos) or Blue Dubes.
 - No boots of any kind are allowed.
- Navy/black/white socks/tights

OUTLINE OF PE UNIFORM (Boys and Girls)

PE uniform which can <u>only</u> be purchased from the school uniform supplier (Kaideen & Co Ltd)

- Coláiste na Mí crested tracksuit hoody
- Coláiste na Mí screen printed T-shirt
- Coláiste na Mí crested tracksuit bottoms/shorts

PE uniform which can be purchased separately by parents

- Appropriate sports runners.
- ❖ Please note that in the interest of health and safety, <u>no casual footwear such as converse/pomps etc</u> will be permitted for PE.
- ❖ PE/Sports bag
- Personal hygiene kit, consisting of roll on deodorant (<u>no aerosols sprays allowed</u>), towel, hairbrush, change of socks.
