

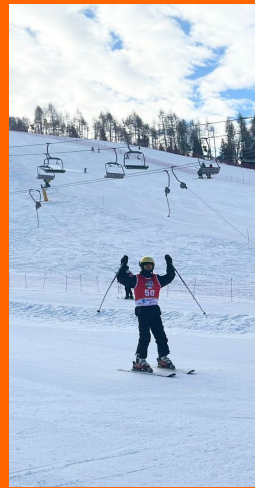
Coláiste na Mí Newsletter
