The Religion Department Mission:

- To identify how understanding of God and religious traditions have contributed to the culture in which we live, and continue to have an impact on personal lifestyle, interpersonal relationships and relationships between individuals and their communities and contexts.

Religious Education is open to all first and second year students. Students have one period of RE each week.

We employ a wide variety of resources including textbooks, ICT, topical newspaper articles, film and literature, guest speakers etc.

The RE department organises activities for November We Remember. The department also runs the St Vincent de Paul food appeal every Christmas.
