Rationale:

In Coláiste na Mí we are very proud to have a uniform which identifies and distinguishes our students. We believe that wearing the school uniform is conducive to good behaviour and helps to focus students.

It is understood that students choosing to enrol in our school accept that the full school uniform (including the wearing of the appropriate school shoes) must be worn during the school day and in travelling to and from school. Parents are asked to show their support in this regard by cooperating fully with the school in ensuring that students wear the full school uniform every day.

Coláiste Na Mí School Uniform Policy

The Coláiste na Mí Uniform Policy applies within this school. All students must abide by this Policy. They sign and return the last page of the document to the school which is then kept on file.

1. All Coláiste na Mí students are expected to maintain a high standard of personal hygiene.
2. All student's hair must be clean and tidy at all times. Long hair should be tied back during practical classes.
3. All students are required to wear the full uniform (as outlined in the uniform list) during the school day and while travelling to and from school. This includes wearing **ALL** black footwear including soles with **NO** coloured or obvious logos/ markings/designs.
4. Appropriate sports runners must be worn by all students for PE class and when wearing the school PE uniform. In the interest of health and safety, casual footwear such as converse/pomps etc will not be permitted to be worn during PE.
5. All students are required to wear the full school uniform when representing the school competitively and on school trips. Any student who is not dressed in the appropriate school uniform will not be permitted to represent the school or travel on school trips.
6. Any student leaving the school premises during the school day must remain in full school uniform.
7. Students must wear navy straight leg school trousers or the Coláiste na Mí skirt.
8. Students are required to wear appropriate hair bands during some practical classes.
9. Small stud sized earrings in ears are acceptable. Clear studs are permitted to keep new piercings open.

10. No jacket other than the school jacket (supplied by Kaideen & Co. Ltd) may be worn under any circumstance. Any non-school jacket worn will be confiscated and held in the principal's office until the end of the school day.
11. The Coláiste na Mí, PE uniform must be worn for all PE classes but may not be worn for any other purpose. The wearing of the PE uniform on any other day except for PE day is strictly forbidden.
12. On occasion the PE uniform may be permitted to be worn on sport related outings. Parents will be informed in advance when this is deemed necessary. Students who are not dressed in the appropriate school uniform will not be permitted to travel on school trips.
13. Students are not permitted to wear any part of their PE uniform, including but not limited to the quarter zip and tracksuit in combination with their regular school uniform during school hours.
14. The wearing of jewellery is not allowed in PE class from a health and safety perspective.
15. It is expected that students and parents maintain and clean the uniform and that pupils wear their uniform with pride.

Important Note

- It is the responsibility of each parent/guardian to ensure every item of their child's uniform is labelled clearly with their child's name. Please use a waterproof marker. ***The school cannot take any responsibility for any item of student property either lost, stolen or damaged while in school.***
- We advise parents/guardians to place an identifiable mark eg a small ribbon/button on the school jacket in a discreet location for easy identification.
- Regular uniform checks will take place.
- There will be regular reminders to students and parents about adhering to the uniform policy.
- If a student attends school without the full school uniform, they may be provided with a loan of the missing item/s of school uniform to be worn for the school day.
- For students who develop a pattern of coming to school out of uniform, their Parent/Guardian will be contacted and the appropriate measures adopted as the school authorities deem fit.
- Students in breach of any school Policy will be dealt with in accordance with our Code of Behaviour.

School Uniform attire

All the items listed below are a compulsory part of the Coláiste na Mí school uniform. They must be worn every day by all students attending the school.

School uniform which can only be purchased from the school uniform supplier (Kaideen & Co Ltd)

- ❖ Coláiste na Mí **green** or **navy** waterproof jacket with navy fleece lining
- ❖ Coláiste na Mí **green** v neck jumper for Junior students
- ❖ Coláiste na Mí **blue** v neck jumper for Senior students
- ❖ Coláiste na Mí school tie
- ❖ Coláiste na Mí tartan skirt for girls

School uniform which can be purchased separately by parents

- ❖ Navy trousers (Girls & Boys) (Trousers are also available for purchase at a reasonable price from our Uniform suppliers)
- ❖ 5 long sleeved white shirts (Shirts are also available for purchase at a reasonable price from our Uniform suppliers)
- ❖ Plain flat, black footwear (no obvious markings or logos). No Ugg style boots are allowed.
- ❖ Navy/black socks/tights

Outline of PE Uniform

PE uniform which can only be purchased from the school uniform supplier (Kaideen & Co Ltd)

- ❖ Coláiste na Mí crested tracksuit quarter zip
- ❖ Coláiste na Mí screen printed T-shirt
- ❖ Coláiste na Mí crested tracksuit bottoms or shorts

PE uniform which can be purchased separately by parents

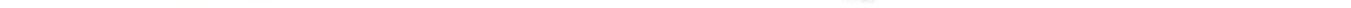
- ❖ Appropriate sports runners.
- ❖ Please note that in the interest of health and safety, no casual footwear such as converse/pomps etc will be permitted for PE.
- ❖ PE/Sports bag

- ❖ Personal hygiene kit, consisting of roll on deodorant (**no aerosols sprays allowed**), towel, hairbrush, change of socks.

Parent/Guardian Responsibilities:

- To ensure that their son/daughter comes to school in correct uniform and to support the school in implementing our uniform policy.
- To properly enforce the uniform policy. The school is dependent on the support of parents and guardians.
- On such occasions where school uniform cannot be worn, Parents/guardians are asked to notify the school in writing. The school may lend an item of uniform for the day, which must be worn on condition that it is washed, dried and returned the following day.

Student Responsibilities:

- Take responsibility for wearing the correct uniform every day.
- Wear full Colaiste na Mi school uniform at all times during school and at school trips.
- Adhere to school uniform policy.

Teacher Responsibilities:

- Check students are wearing full uniform in class.
- Use dialann to record uniform issues.
- Caomhnoir to check uniform daily, record issues in dialann and check that parents have signed.
- Caomhnoir to discuss uniform issue with student.
- Caomhnoir to report unresolved uniform issue to the uniform officer and or Deputy Principal/ Year Head.
- Caomhnoir, uniform officer/DP to offer support to student in terms of offering uniform item to student if available.

School Responsibilities:

- Implement Uniform Policy once ratified by the BOM.
- Implement sanctions on breach of uniform rules.
- May contact parents/guardians.
- Ask parents/guardians to bring correct uniform into school or take their Son/Daughter home to correct the uniform.
- Students may be kept out of class until uniform is rectified.
